The Direct Funding Self-Managed Attendant Services Program is an innovated program that enables adults over the age of 16 with physical disabilities to become employers of their own attendants. Attendants assist with routine activities of daily living such as dressing, grooming, bathing, transferring, etc. RISE: Resource Centre of Independent Living is proud to offer this program because it exemplifies the spirit of consumer-directed care that is at the heart of all our services. Direct Funding allows for attendant service up to seven hours a day, for a maximum of 212 hours a month. The amount of service funded is individually negotiated. This program allows you to oversee your own staff, schedule your attendants to meet your specific daily needs, receive monthly funds to pay your attendants, and live wherever you like in the province of Ontario.
