

Vaping among Students in Grades 7 to 12 within the Health Unit Region

Last updated: April 24th, 2024

Summary

In the 2022/2023 school year the North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit (Health Unit) was involved in an oversample of the Ontario Student Drug Use and Health Survey (OSDUHS) conducted by the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH). This oversample included 14 elementary schools (361 students across grades 7 and 8) and 6 secondary schools (374 students in grades 9-12) in the Health Unit district. This totaled 735 student responses.

Across the Health Unit district, 20.4% (95% CI= 13.9-28.9) of students used a vaping device in the previous 12 months, this was not significantly different from other northern health units (17.4%, 95% CI = 13.2-22.6) or Ontario (13.4%, 95% CI=12.1-14.8). Table 1 compares the percentage of students who initiated vaping in grade 12 or before, and percentage of students who have used a vaping device in grade 12 or before and vaped in the previous 12 months.

Table 2 compares the percentage of students who have used a vaping device in the previous 12 months, initiated vaping in grade 12 or before, or who have used a vaping device in grade 12 or before and vaped in the previous 12 months by sex assigned ay birth. Statistical significance was only observed between sexes at the provincial level across the three vaping usage variables (Table 2). Specifically, across the three vaping usage measures, female students were reported at a higher percentage.

Table 3 displays percentages of students for initiation of vaping and cannabis use, along with the percentage of students who have smoked tobacco and used a vaping device. There is a statistical difference between the percentage of students in the Health Unit region who have smoked tobacco and used a vaping device when compared to Ontario (5.0%, 95% CI=3.3-7.6; 2.45%, 95% CI=2-3%, respectively).

Table 4 displays similar information as Table 3 but delineates by sex assigned at birth. There are distinct differences between sexes at the provincial level for initiating vaping and cannabis use in grade 12 or before provincially. Specifically, female students have reported a statistically higher percentage of using cannabis and vaping devices in the previous 12 months when compared to males, 20.8% vs. 12.6% (Table 4). Further, a higher percentage of females have initiated vaping and or cannabis use in grade 12 or before within the Health Unit region when compared to Ontario (38.9% vs 20.8%). This was found to be statistically significant (Table 4).
